Big Bend National Park
Terlingua Texas

Stay at the beautiful Paisano Village RV Park and Inn in Study Butte Texas. We have reserved 10 RV sites with concrete pads. Paisano RV Park is about 2 miles outside the entrance of Big Bend National Park! Big Bend State Park is less than an hour away. Terlingua ghost town is right up the road.

- Explore the rugged Chisos Mountains with steep canyons, amazing views
- Hiking trails short or long, easy, or arduous
- Hike or drive some of the "unimproved" dirt roads

The location is the Shipshewana North Campground and Cabins. This is Dave and Tina's Rally and not VB, but they have graciously agreed to let us begin our Rolling Rally with

them. They have perfected the perfect low stress rally. No schedules, no events, just a great get together. There are many things to see and do in the area.



This is Amish Country with great stores, garage sales, restaurants and a huge flea market on Tuesday and Wednesday. Can't promise, but in the past, Rowland and JoAnne Rose have opened up their "Arcade Home" which has to be seen and experienced. There are several RV surplus stores in the area for the guys to go to multiple times during our visit, once is never enough! There is also a local shop which works on AC units and propane refrigerators; this shop has a very good reputation. The official dates are Wednesday, June 7 to Sunday, June 11, 2023. Many of us will come early and make a week of it.

Sunday, June 11, 2023, at 8 AM is the target time to leave Shipshewana for the 4 hour drive (240 miles) to Mahomet IL. We will be staying at the Tin Cup RV Park for the night. Mahomet is a small town west of Champaign/Urbana IL and home to the "Museum of the Grand Prairie". We will tour the museum and grounds on Sunday afternoon.

Monday June 12, 2023, AM we will depart for Springfield IL for a short 1½ hour, 85 mile drive. We will be staying at the Illinois State Fairgrounds in Springfield. Our hosts for our Springfield adventure will be David and Dawn Hollis. David is a retired firefighter in Springfield and knows the ins and outs of the city. There are many things to see and do in the area. A major theme of Springfield is, of course, Abraham Lincoln. His restored home, law offices and the old state capitol building where Lincoln delivered his famous House Divided Speech are open for tours. Many people pay their respects at the President's tomb in Oak Ridge Cemetery. Lincoln's Presidential Library is also in town.



Friday, June 16, we have a 2 hour, 125 mile drive to St. Peters, MO. We will be camping at 370 Lakeside Park, St Peters, MO. Gary and Molly Shilling will be the hosts for the St Louis Rally. We will be relying on Dave and Dawn for "must see" things to see and do for they also have spent quite a bit of time in St Louis. It is a 30 minute drive to downtown St Louis from our campground in St Peters. There are so many things to see and do in the St. Louis area. The charming old town area of St. Charles is amazing,

with shops, restaurants and the Lewis and Clark Boat House and Museum.



There is, of course, the Gateway Arch and Museum which should not be missed. White Haven, the home of Ulysses S Grant, is a National Historic Site which also has a museum on the premises. The St Louis Zoo is world class. And there is much more! I'm sure we will not run out of things to do.

The Vintage Birds Chapter of FMCA was chartered in December 1984 for owners of Bluebird Wanderlodge coaches. To have active membership status, you must own or previously owned a Bluebird Wanderlodge or a Bluebird Motor Coach (BMC) and be an FMCA member in good standing.

The purpose of the Chapter is to provide social, recreational, and informational activities associated with enjoyment and pleasurable use of the Bluebird Wanderlodge and BMC coaches; a forum for the exchange of information on the maintenance, modification, and updating of members' coaches; and long term and community wide leadership in promoting the vintage bird coach through support for all vintage bird communities.

To achieve our purpose the Chapter engages in numerous activities including: rally support for hosting and supporting rallies throughout our great country, our Vintage Birds web site at http://www.vintagebirds.com/index.html which supports a very inclusive web site that lists All Bluebird Rallies, vintage bird coach information and coaches for sale, our Newsletter capturing Bluebird rally information and member social input, and our Vintage Birds Facebook Group providing members a social gathering place to post member adventures and social exchanges. see https://www.facebook.com/groups/2187641018189972/

The initial fee is \$30. This fee covers name badges and your first-year dues of \$15. Subsequent year dues are \$15, or you can take advantage of our promotional rate of \$40 for 3 years or \$60 for 5 years! For those members desiring a lifetime membership, a Vintage Birds Lifetime Membership is \$325. Paid dues are non-refundable.

Once you have paid Vintage Birds dues your application is classified as pending. When you have satisfied all FMCA membership requirements your application is classified as an active member, and you will be able to vote, and hold elected office in the Chapter.
